This is a settlement for Kiribertese (Gilbertese) that migrated in late 1950 and early 1960. There are three other settlements apart from Arariki that has estimated population of 460 people. Their main source of income is from marine resources like bech-de-mer, fish, trochus and farming seaweed.

My Cluster group member distributed 9 boxes of bras and 1 box of box children wear.

Posarae and Pututu Villages, Choiseul

The estimated population of these two villages is 840 people. They earned income mainly from selling produces at the market, copra & coca and timber milling.

The items distributed to the women were 18 boxes of bras, 3 boxes of kitchenware and a box linen.
